For suspected or confirmed trafficking, contact the National Human Trafficking Hotline at **888-373-7888** or text **233733**. To report suspected trafficking in Ohio, call **844-END-OHHT**. Local services vary by county and may include emergency response, advocacy, shelter, temporary housing, trauma therapy, and youth or adult residential services.
